SRC Infrastructure has put this Sustainability Policy in place to ensure that we comply with our environmental obligations and behave as a company in an environmentally responsible manner.

This Policy is based upon the following principles:

- SRC Infrastructure will comply with, and exceed where practicable, all applicable legislation, regulations and codes of practice.
- We will integrate sustainability considerations into all our business decisions.
- We will ensure that all staff are fully aware of our Sustainability Policy and are committed to implementing and improving it.
- We will attempt to minimise the impact on sustainability of all office and transportation activities.
- We will keep our sustainability performance under review, and continually strive to improve it.

In order to put these principles into practice we will:

- Walk, cycle and/or use public transport to attend meetings, site visits etc, apart from in exceptional circumstances where the alternatives are impractical and/or cost prohibitive.
- Avoid physically travelling to meetings etc where alternatives are available and practical, such as using teleconferencing, video conferencing or web cams, and efficient timing of meetings to avoid multiple trips. These options are also often more time efficient, while not sacrificing the benefits of regular contact with clients and partners.
- Minimise our use of paper and other office consumables and identifying opportunities to reduce waste.
- As far as possible arrange for the reuse or recycling of office waste, including paper, computer supplies and redundant equipment.
- Reduce the energy consumption of office equipment by purchasing energy efficient equipment and good housekeeping.
- Follow a Green Procurement Policy to minimise the environmental impacts of our business.
